**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that **DELIA REEVES NEAL** be, and she is hereby reappointed to serve as Justice of the Peace Pro Tempore for Precinct No. 7 for a period commencing January 1, 2008 and ending December 31, 2008.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that **DELIA REEVES NEAL** be compensated in accordance with state law; payable through the Justice of the Peace, Precinct No. 7, budget.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that **DELIA REEVES NEAL** be entitled to mileage reimbursement from her home in Mesa, Arizona, to any duly assigned work place in Pinal County, Arizona, at the duly authorized rate, also payable through the Justice Court's budget.

This appointment is at the pleasure and direction of the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court. Such appointment may be terminated without cause at any time by the Presiding Judge.
