2<sup>ND</sup> AMENDED

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** amending Administrative Order No. 200900046 to include the Eloy City Magistrate; and

**WHEREAS**, the Presiding Juvenile Court Judge may decline jurisdiction and appoint certain justices of the peace and city court judges to serve as juvenile hearing officers; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Pinal County Board of Supervisors and the City Councils of Kearny, Coolidge, Casa Grande, Florence and Apache Junction have agreed to the appointment of their respective officers serving in the capacity of Juvenile Hearing Officers; now, therefore,

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** appointment the following Justices of the Peace and City Court Judges as Juvenile Hearing Officers to process, adjudicate and dispose of all cases in which a child under the age of 18 years on the date of the alleged offense is charged with violating any of the laws as set forth in A.R.S. §8-323(B), with the exception of driving under the influence, unless specifically approved by the Presiding Juvenile Court Judge on a case by case basis.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that once all orders by the Juvenile Hearing Officers have been fully complied with, the Juvenile Hearing Officer shall immediately transmit a copy of the citation with the findings and disposition of the court noted on the copy to Juvenile Court, for recordkeeping purposes as set forth in A.R.S. §8-323(G).

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that all copies of juvenile citations, findings and dispositions shall be transmitted to the Pinal County Department of Juvenile Court Services no later than the 10<sup>th</sup> day of each month commencing the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April, 2009, and continuing thereafter until further ordered.




