**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**

NO. 2009- 60

**WHEREAS:** Arizona Revised Statutes §13-3422 authorizes the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court in each county to establish a drug court program as defined in §13-3401; and,

**WHEREAS:** Arizona Revised Statutes §13-3401 (10) defines a drug court program as a program that is established pursuant to §13-3422 by the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court in cooperation with the county attorney in a county for the purpose of prosecuting, adjudicating and treating drug dependent persons who meet the criteria and guidelines for entry into the program that are developed and agreed on by the presiding judge and the prosecutor; and,

**WHEREAS:** The Pinal County Adult Drug Court planning committee has created a set of procedures, including criteria and guidelines for entry into the program, which may be amended from time to time by action of the Administrative Presiding Judge of the Adult Drug Court, with the approval of the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court, to guide the functioning of the Adult Drug Court; and,


**WHEREAS:** The Pinal County Adult Drug Court planning committee includes representatives from the Pinal County Superior Court Bench, the Pinal County Attorney's Office, the Pinal County Public Defender's Office, the Pinal County Adult Probation Department, the Casa Grande Police Department, and Horizon Human Services;

**NOW, THEREFORE,** pursuant to Article 6, Section 11 of the Arizona Constitution and Arizona Revised Statutes §13-3401 and §13-3422,

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** establishing an Adult Drug Court Program within the Pinal County Superior Court; and, those procedures created by the Pinal County Adult Drug Court planning committee, and any amendments thereto, are hereby adopted and incorporated by and into this Administrative Order.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** appointing the **HONORABLE STEPHEN F. McCARVILLE** as Administrative Presiding Judge of the Adult Drug Court in Pinal County.
