WHEREAS the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in and for Pinal County is the chief judicial officer of the county and has administrative authority over all courts in Pinal County, pursuant to Article VI of the Arizona Constitution and Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 2005-32 (revised May 16, 2005); and

WHEREAS the resources and caseload of the Superior Court have changed since the prior Administrative Orders that allocated resources, which therefore requires a modification in the assignment and adjudication of cases.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED affirming all prior case assignments, as set forth in prior Orders that are in effect, including Administrative Order 2009-75 and this order shall serve to clarify Administrative Order 2009-72.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED any new Petition for an Order of Protection shall be consolidated into any pending Dissolution, Separation or Paternity, involving the same parties. As to any such new Petition, the Clerk of the Court shall promptly refer such petitions to the assigned Superior Court Division, which shall handle the matter as set forth in Administrative Order 2009-75.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that <u>all</u> new Domestic Relations files (identified by the prefix DO), regardless of the specific case type, filed on or after the date of this Administrative Order, shall be assigned as follows:

New Petitions for Order of Protection (petitions that are NOT consolidated into an existing file, which are the opening document for the file) shall be assigned to the <u>Family Law Commissioner</u>. As to any such new Petition, the Clerk of the Court shall promptly refer such petitions to the Family Law Commissioner.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED Remaining new Domestic Relations Files shall be assigned as determined by the two terminal digits of each file as follows:

Even numbered terminal digits shall be assigned to the Honorable Brenda E. Oldham.

Odd numbered terminal digits shall be assigned to the Honorable Kevin D.White.
