IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **MICHELLE O'HAIR-SCHATTENBERG** be compensated in accordance with state law; payable through the Justice of the Peace, Precinct No. 7, budget.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **MICHELLE O'HAIR-SCHATTENBERG** be entitled to mileage reimbursement from her home in Chandler, Arizona, to any duly assigned work place in Pinal County, Arizona, at the duly authorized rate, also payable through the Justice Court's budget.

This appointment is at the pleasure and direction of the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court. Such appointment may be terminated without cause at any time by the Presiding Judge

Dear Judge Olson:

Please consider this as a letter of interest to serve as a pro tem judge in the limited jurisdiction courts in Pinal County. Allow me to set out my qualifications.

I retired in January of this year after serving for 14 years as a judge in the Tempe Municipal Court. I was assigned to a full-time division and handled all types of cases and proceedings. The full-time judges in Tempe Municipal Court have one of the highest judge-to-case ratios in the entire state, so I learned early on in my tenure to be efficient and yet adjudicate each case on its own merits.

Prior to my appointment to the Tempe bench, I was a prosecutor for 14 years, serving in the Navajo County Attorney's Office, the Mesa City Prosecutor's Office and the Maricopa County Attorney's Office. I was involved in all aspects of prosecution, including working in the justice courts doing case evaluation, pleas and preliminary hearings.

Since I have been retired I have been working as a pro tem in the cities of Tempe, Chandler, Mesa and Apache Junction. I have also worked in various justice courts in Maricopa County, doing both civil and criminal calendars. I am also on the pro tem list for the Yavapai County limited jurisdiction courts.

I do believe that I have the qualifications to serve in the limited jurisdiction courts of Pinal County as a pro tem judge. Please feel free to contact me if you need further information.
