WHEREAS, the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in Pinal County is the chief judicial officer of the county and has administrative authority over all courts in Pinal County pursuant to Article VI of the Arizona Constitution, Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 2005-32, issued May 16, 2005, and Rule 92, Rules of the Supreme Court of Arizona; and,

WHEREAS, on June 27, 2008, the Governor of the State of Arizona approved a statewide photo enforcement program (A.R.S. § 41-1722) to be operated by the Arizona Department of Public Safety and those complaints being filed in the Justice Courts; and,

WHEREAS, the Arizona Supreme Court adopted Rules of Court that govern the operation of the photo enforcement program in the Arizona Rules of Civil Traffic and Civil Boating Cases (Rules 38-46); and rules to effect service of process in the Rules of Civil Procedure (Rules 4(d), 4(g), and 4(i)) which authorizes service of process within 90 days of the filing of the complaint, and in consideration of A.R.S. § 28-1593(A); and,

WHEREAS, the best interests of justice, as well of the efficient operation of our Courts, requires that cases be dismissed when the time for service has expired,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that photo enforcement complaints shall be promptly dismissed, *sua sponte*, if proof of timely service (or a written waiver of service) is not provided to the Court within the thirty calendar days after the time for service has expired. The time for service of a citation may only be extended for good cause shown, if requested by the State in writing prior to the expiration of the time for service.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the no fee for service of process shall be imposed for any citation that is dismissed pursuant to the Administrative Order.
