

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to A.R.S. Sec. 22-121 (B),


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that DAVID ALEXANDER be, and he is hereby appointed to serve as Justice of the Peace Pro Tempore for Precinct No. 6 for a period commencing June 1, 2010 and ending December 31, 2010, subject to the approval of the Board of Supervisors.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that DAVID ALEXANDER be compensated in accordance with state law; payable through the Justice of the Peace, Precinct No. 6, budget.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that DAVID ALEXANDER be entitled to mileage reimbursement from his home in Apache Junction, Arizona, to any duly assigned work place in Pinal County, Arizona, at the duly authorized rate, also payable through the Justice Court's budget.

This appointment is at the pleasure and direction of the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court. Such appointment may be terminated without cause at any time by the Presiding Judge
