**WHEREAS** the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of Arizona, in and for Pinal County, is the chief executive judicial officer of the county and has administrative authority over all courts in Pinal County, pursuant to Article VI of the Arizona Constitution and Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 2005-32 (revised May 16, 2005); and,

**WHEREAS**, the divisions of the Superior Court are periodically renumbered, traditionally based upon the seniority of each judicial officer; and,

**WHEREAS** the Presiding Judge may delegate certain authority over of the Superior Court, in and for Pinal County, to assist in the efficient administration of the Court,

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the ten elected division of the Superior Court are hereinafter renumbered for all purposes, including election districts, as follows:

- Hon. Gilberto V. Figueroa, Division 2
- Hon. Stephen F. McCarville, Division 3
- Hon. Janna L. Vanderpool, Division 4
- Hon. Kevin D. White, Division 5
- Hon. Joseph R. Georgini, Division 6
- Hon. Robert Carter Olson, Division 7
- Hon. Brenda E. Oldham, Division 8
- Hon. Steven J. Fuller, Division 9
- Hon. Daniel A. Washburn, Division 10


**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** affirming the prior appointment of the Hon. Gilberto V. Figueroa as Associate Presiding Judge of Pinal County, as previously approved by the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Arizona.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** delegating the authority of the Presiding Judge to the following jurists as presiding judges of their respective benches:

Hon. Kevin D. White, Juvenile Presiding Judge  
Hon. Stephen F. McCarville, Family Law Presiding Judge

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the presiding judge for each bench is delegated general authority over their bench, except as modified or limited by Administrative Order or direction by the Presiding Judge, and shall specifically supervise staff judges that are assigned to the bench, coordinate coverage, reassign cases within the bench as required, and provide a monthly reassignment report to the Presiding Judge.
