
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2011-10

Article 6, §20 of the Arizona Constitution and Administrative Order 2001-62, issued on June 20, 2001, authorize presiding judges to temporarily call back to active duty retired justices or judges, listed as qualified by the Administrative Director of the Arizona Supreme Court, to serve as a judge of the superior court.

IT IS ORDERED that **JUDGE (Retired) WILLIAM J. O'NEIL** is called to active duty to serve as a judge of this court and is assigned to perform the following duties: To conduct all necessary proceedings in specifically Pinal County Cause CV20070063, William D. Troutt vs. Mary Troutt, et al., and any other cases/matters which may be identified by the Presiding Judge, which Judge O'Neil shall accept.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **JUDGE (Retired) WILLIAM J. O'NEIL** shall receive compensation and expenses as provided in Article 6, §20 of the Arizona Constitution and A.R.S. §38-813(B), which currently calculates to an hourly compensation in the amount of \$13.94 per hour.
