**NOW, THEREFORE**, pursuant to A.R.S. Sec. 22-121 (B),



**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that **MICHAEL L. BOWMAN** be entitled to mileage reimbursement from his home in Florence, Arizona, to any duly assigned work place in Pinal County, Arizona, at the duly authorized rate, also payable through the Justice Court's budget.

This appointment is at the pleasure and direction of the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court. Such appointment may be terminated without cause at any time by the Presiding Judge.
