ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

WHEREAS, the Presiding judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in Pinal County exercises administrative supervision over the Judicial Branch of Government in Pinal County;


WHEREAS, pursuant to A.R.S. §13-901(A), when granting probation in the Superior Court to an adult, the Court as a condition of probation, shall assess a monthly fee, unless after determining the inability of the probationer to pay the fee, the court waives or reduced the fee.

WHEREAS, offenders placed on unsupervised probation receive assessment, monitoring, petition and accountability services which results in costs that are otherwise a general obligation to the public;

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that effective July 1, 2011, that all offenders placed on unsupervised probation in the Superior Court in Pinal County shall be assessed a monthly probation services fee of not less than \$35.00 per month, as authorized by A.R.S. § 13-901(A), unless after determining the inability of the probation to pay the fee, the court waives or reduces the fee.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that said fees shall be depositing in the Probation Services Fund of the Pinal County Treasurer as provided by A.R.S. § 12-267 (A)(3).
