WHEREAS the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in and for Pinal County is the chief judicial office of the county and has administrative authority over all courts in Pinal Count, pursuant to Article VI of the Arizona Constitution and Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 2005-32 (revised may 16, 2005); and,

WHEREAS the Presiding judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in Pinal County exercised administrative supervision over all Justice of the Peace Court in Pinal County; and

It appearing that good cause exists for the appointment of **JUDY FERGUSON** as Justice of the Peace Pro Tem.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to A.R.S. Sec. 22-121 (B),

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that **JUDY FERGUSON** be, and she is hereby appointed to serve as Justice of the Peace Pro Tempore for Precinct No. 8 IMMEDIATELY for a period as necessary as determined by the Presiding Judge, Honorable Stephen F. McCarville,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **JUDY FERGUSON** be compensated in accordance with state law; payable through the Justice of the Peace, Precinct No. 8, budget.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **JUDY FERGUSON** be entitled to mileage reimbursement from her home in Casa Grande, Arizona, to any duly assigned work place in Pinal County, Arizona, at the duly authorized rate, also payable through the Justice Court's budget.

This appointment is at the pleasure and direction of the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court. Such appointment may be terminated without cause at any time by the Presiding Judge.
