**WHEREAS** the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in Pinal County exercises administrative supervision over the operations of the Pinal County Adult Probation Department and Juvenile Court Services;

**WHEREAS** as a condition of probation the Adult Probation Department/Juvenile Court Services may seize illegal items and/or contraband from subjects under their supervision and a process is necessary to dispose of such items;

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that PCAPD/JCS may, upon approval of the chief probation officer, properly transfer to a law enforcement authority, confiscated contraband no longer needed for evidentiary purposes and for which no legitimate claim has been made. Seized property becomes eligible for disposal two years following confiscation.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that at least two of the following personnel be present during the transfer of contraband:

- the chief probation officer
- any division director with Adult Probation or Juvenile Court Services
- any probation supervisor designated by the chief probation officer
