
NOW, THEREFORE pursuant to A.R.S. § 22-121(B),

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that **SANDRA LEOS** be and she is hereby appointed to serve as Justice of the Peace *Pro Tempore*, for a period commencing March, 10, 2015 and ending December 31, 2015.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **SANDRA LEOS** shall receive no additional compensation or benefits other than the compensation and benefits she receives as a result of her status as a full-time employee of the Casa Grande Justice Court.

This appointment is at the pleasure and direction of the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court. Such appointment may be terminated without cause at any time by the Presiding Judge.
