**WHEREAS** the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in and for Pinal County is the chief judicial officer of the county and has administrative authority over all the courts in Pinal County, pursuant to Article VI of the Arizona Constitution and Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 2005-32 (revised May 16, 2005); and,

**WHEREAS** the Honorable Thomas R. Shoppe, Justice of the Peace, Precinct No. 1; has requested the reappointment of David Orzell; and

**WHEREAS** the Presiding Judge finds that the afore-listed request for reappointment is necessary, appropriate and in the best interest of the Judicial Branch of Government in Pinal County;

**NOW, THEREFORE** pursuant to A.R.S. § 22-121(B),

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that **DAVID J. ORZELL** be and he is hereby reappointed to serve as Justice of the Peace *Pro Tempore, nunc pro tunc*, for a period commencing January 1, 2016, and ending December 31, 2015.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that **DAVID J. ORZELL** be compensated in accordance with state law; payable through funds budgeted in the Judicial Branch and/or the Justices of the Peace for such purposes.


This appointment is at the pleasure and direction of the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court. Such appointment may be terminated without cause at any time by the Presiding Judge.
