Pursuant to the Constitution of the State of Arizona, Art. 6, Sec. 24, A.R.S. §12-213, as amended, and Rule 96 of the Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court (RASC),

**IT IS ORDERED** that Lawrence M. Wharton is hereby appointed, nunc pro tunc from July 1, 2014, on a full time basis, as a Court Commissioner of the Superior Court of Arizona in Pinal County with the working title of "Commissioner." Lawrence M. Wharton shall serve one uninterrupted term of service, until retirement, resignation or termination.


**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Lawrence M. Wharton shall have all such powers and duties pursuant to law which shall include, but not be limited to, those powers and duties prescribed by A.R.S. §12-213, as amended, and Rule 96, RASC, as amended.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Lawrence M. Wharton shall be compensated according to the existing compensation plan for a Commissioner of the Superior Court in Pinal County, and

This appointment is conditioned upon the agreement to serve only for the compensation received as a Court Commissioner while employed as a Commissioner by the Court, and to receive no additional compensation or benefit, fiscal or otherwise, when acting in the capacity of a Judge Pro Tempore.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Lawrence M. Wharton is assigned to hear and decide matters assigned to him by the Presiding Judge, without further written order.
