ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
NO. 102017 00010

WHEREAS, the Presiding Judge has general administrative authority over the Judicial Branch of government in Pinal County pursuant to Article VI of Arizona Constitution Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 2005-32 issued May 16, 2006 and Rule 92, Rules of the Supreme Court of Arizona and,

WHEREAS, the Presiding Judge of Pinal County has determined in accordance with the provisions and authority of A.R.S. 11-584 and 8-221 that the court shall order an administrative assessment fees of not more than twenty-five dollars to be paid by the juvenile or the juvenile's parent or guardian for those cases assigned public defender representation at the preliminary examination.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the court shall automatically order an indigent administrative assessment of not more than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00). The minute entry will be prepared to reflect the order of the fees to be paid by the juvenile or the juvenile's parent or guardian on cases where representation by County Public Defender's Office is appointed at the preliminary examination. Failure to obey may be enforced in the manner of a civil judgment.

FURTHERMORE, assessments collected shall be submitted to the County Treasurer in accordance with Minimum Accounting Standards (as defined under Section 1-401 of the Arizona Code of Judicial Administration). The County Treasurer shall deposit the collected amount in the county general fund in the account designed for use solely by the public defender.
