ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
No. 2018 - 08

**WHEREAS** the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of Arizona, in and for Pinal County, is the chief executive judicial officer of the county and has administrative authority over all courts in Pinal County, pursuant to Article VI of the Arizona Constitution and Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order NO. 2017-79; and,

**WHEREAS**, Article 2, Section 2.1 of the Arizona Constitution; and, Rule 39 of the Arizona Rules of Criminal Procedure, set forth the rights of victims of crime, and,

**WHEREAS**, Rule 1003 of the Arizona Rules of Evidence provides that a duplicate is admissible to the same extent as the original unless a genuine question is raised about the original's authenticity or the circumstances make it unfair to admit the duplicate,

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that pursuant to Rule 1003 of the Arizona Rules of Evidence, the Pinal County Clerk of the Superior Court shall accept duplicate Victim Loss Statements under Article 2, Section 2.1 of the Arizona Constitution; and, Rule 39 of the Arizona Rules of Criminal Procedure, for filing.
