ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED affirming all current duties and assignments of all full-time and part-time judicial officers of the Superior Court, except where modified by this Administrative Order, effective January 2, 2019.



These matters should be reassigned as soon as practical, by whatever method deemed most appropriate by the Presiding Family Law Judge, but case transfer shall be completed no later than February 1, 2019, and thereafter on a case-by-case basis by the Presiding Family Law Judge.
