ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

NO. 2019-00007

WHEREAS the Presiding Judge or the Presiding Juvenile Court Judge may decline jurisdiction and appoint certain justices of the peace and city court judges to serve as juvenile court hearing officers; and,

WHEREAS the Pinal County Board of Supervisors and the City/Town Councils of Eloy, Kearny, Coolidge, Casa Grande, Florence and Apache Junction have agreed to the appointment of their respective officers to serve in the capacity of Juvenile Hearing Officers;

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED appointing, the following Justices of the Peace and City Magistrates to serve as Juvenile Hearing Officers to process, adjudicate and dispose of all cases in which a child under the age of 18 years on the date of the alleged offense is charged with violating any of the laws as set forth in A.R.S. §8-323(B), with the exception of driving under the influence, unless specifically approved by the Presiding Juvenile Court Judge on a case by case basis.



IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that within five days after receiving the citation, the Juvenile Hearing Officer shall notify the juvenile court that the juvenile has been charged with an offense and shall indicate the listed charges; and,

Within five days after disposition, the Juvenile Hearing Officer shall transmit a copy of the citation and the findings and disposition of the court noted on the copy, as set forth in A.R.S. §8-323(H) and the Pinal County Justice/Municipal Courts Policy and Procedure, dated June 7, 2014, and titled "Reporting Juvenile Case Information to Juvenile Court Services".

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the aforementioned appointments or reappointments shall serve under the same terms and conditions of the existing appointment, but said appointment shall expire on December 31, 2019.
