

Electronic Filing of Subsequent Documents in Criminal Cases Soon to be Available in eFileAZ

In an effort to assist the Arizona superior court with conducting business in a manner that reduces the risk associated with the current public health emergency, the Arizona Supreme Court has recently expanded the eFileAZ e filing application to accept electronic filings of subsequent documents in Criminal cases. This enhancement will be implemented in thirteen of Arizona's fifteen counties over the next couple of weeks. Maricopa and Pima counties will be supported at a later date.

The electronic filing of subsequent documents into criminal cases will not be mandatory at this time. This enhancement was implemented to provide filing parties an alternative to mailing in paper or appearing in person at a court building.

The Arizona Supreme Court anticipates expanding the ability to electronically file into additional case types in the coming weeks. More information will be provided as it becomes available.
