# REQUEST TO MODIFY CHILD SUPPORT

A Request to Modify Child Support is filed as a result of a 15%, or greater, difference on your current Child Support Order, which is calculated by completing a Parent's Worksheet for Child Support form.

## **FEES**

#### WHEN FILING

Originals get filed with the Clerk's Office

\*\* 2 copies get conformed, one for the petitioner and the other for the respondent (post notarization). A self addressed stamped envelope must be submitted for the mailing of conformed copies.

If the County Attorney Child Support Division has been involved with your case, you **MUST** also serve the County Attorney's Office with conformed copies and an *Acceptance of Service*.

# **METHODS OF SERVICE**

Acceptance of Service Restricted Registered Mail Private Process Server Sheriff Officer

#### **SERVICE**

Once the respondent is served, the respondent has 20 days to file a Request for Hearing if he/she lives in AZ and 30 days if he/she lives out of state. Petitioner may file for Request for Hearing any time after.

#### **POSSIBLE OUTCOMES**

- If a Request for Hearing is filed and a hearing is set, you will receive written notice of the date, time and location to appear for Court.
- After time has lapsed and no party requests a hearing, the Judge may grant your request and sign the Income Withholding Order/Notice for Support.
- The Judge may schedule a hearing to obtain further information and all parties will receive written notice of the date, time and location to appear for Court.
