ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

WHEREAS, the Honorable PHIL BAIN, Justice of the Peace, Precinct No. 2, has requested the reappointment of TERRY SUTTON as Justice of the Peace Pro Tempore; and,

It appearing that good cause exists for the reappointment of TERRY SUTTON as a Justice of the Peace Pro Tempore, for Pinal County, Arizona; and,

It further appearing that the said TERRY SUTTON is qualified and willing to serve in such capacity during said period;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to A.R.S. Sec. 22-121 (B),

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that TERRY SUTTON be, and he is hereby reappointed to serve as Justice of the Peace Pro Tempore for Precinct No. 2 for a period commencing January 1, 2010 and ending December 31, 2010.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that TERRY SUTTON be compensated in accordance with state law; payable through the Justice of the Peace, Precinct No. 2, budget.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that TERRY SUTTON be entitled to mileage reimbursement from his home in Casa Grande, Arizona, to any duly assigned work place in Pinal County, Arizona, at the duly authorized rate, also payable through the Justice Court's budget.

This appointment is at the pleasure and direction of the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court. Such appointment may be terminated without cause at any time by the Presiding Judge.
