ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
No. 2014 - 00069

**WHEREAS** the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in Pinal County exercises administrative supervision over the Superior Court, Clerk of the Superior Court, Justice of the Peace Courts and Municipal Courts;

**WHEREAS** improving the accuracy of criminal history record reporting is a legitimate function of the courts, impacted by consistent transmission of information to law enforcement;

**WHEREAS** the use of different warrant forms by each court within Pinal County has contributed to incomplete criminal history reporting;

**WHEREAS** a countywide workgroup consisting of representatives from the Clerk of Superior Court, Justice Courts, Municipal Courts, and Pinal County Sheriff's Office has worked with forms suggested by the Administrative Office of the Supreme Court to develop a set of forms for Pinal County;

**WHEREAS** those forms have been reviewed by representatives from the Administrative Office of the Supreme Court, the Presiding Judge of the Pinal County Justice Courts, the Presiding Judge of the Pinal County Municipal Courts (as elected by his peers), and a representative of the Pinal County Superior Court Bench; and

Good cause appearing,

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** approving the attached set of warrant forms for use by all courts within Pinal County, effective April 7, 2014, and directing that no court shall make any changes to these forms without approval from the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court.
