ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

WHEREAS the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in and for Pinal County is the chief judicial officer of the county and has administrative authority over all the courts in Pinal County, pursuant to Article VI of the Arizona Constitution and Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 2017-79; and,

WHEREAS the Honorable Nancy Discher, Justice of the Peace, Precinct No. 5 has retired, and

WHEREAS the Presiding Judge finds that the appointment of a Justice of the Peace *Pro tempore* is necessary, appropriate and in the best interest of the Judicial Branch of Government in Pinal County;

NOW, THEREFORE pursuant to A.R.S. § 22-121(B),


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that **Ellie Brown** is hereby appointed to serve as Justice of the Peace *Pro Tempore*, District 5, for a period commencing January 31, 2021 and ending December 31, 2021, or, until the Pinal County Board of Supervisors have appointed a Justice of the Peace.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **Ellie Brown** shall be compensated in accordance with state law under A.R.S. §22-122.D. , by funds allocated for such purposes from the budget of the Judicial Branch and/or the budget of the Justices of the Peace; and,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERD that **Ellie Brown** shall comply with all Judicial Canons; and, receive any judicial training as required by the Administrative Offices of the Courts.

This appointment is at the pleasure and direction of the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court. Such appointment may be terminated without cause at any time by the Presiding Judge.
