WHEREAS, the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in and for Pinal County is the Chief Judicial Executive Officer of the County and has administrative supervision over all courts in Pinal County pursuant to Article VI of the Arizona Constitution and Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 2017-79; and

WHEREAS, it is recognized that the Clerk of the Superior Court receives and receipts payments from any defendant for any court ordered fines, surcharges, fees, assessments, and victim restitution; and

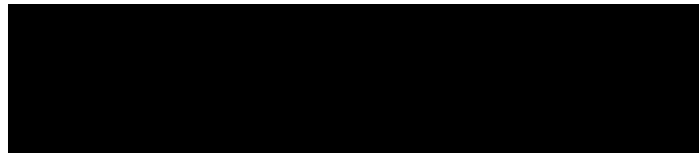
WHEREAS, it is recognized that certain fines, surcharges, assessments and fees may place a financial strain on certain defendants, decreasing the likelihood they will be successful in the community; and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of justice that defendants be enabled, to the greatest extent possible, to pay criminal restitution to victims in full; and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of justice that qualifying defendants under probation supervision be permitted to perform community restitution in lieu of certain court ordered fines, surcharges, assessments and fees, at the discretion of the Adult Probation Department;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the Clerk of the Superior Court in Pinal County, together with Pinal County Adult Probation establish policies and procedures, which may be modified from time to time, to guide the implementation of Arizona Revised Statutes § 13-824, as it relates to criminal defendants under probation supervision in the Pinal County Superior Court with a verifiable financial need.
