ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

No. 2021-00069

WHEREAS, the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in and for Pinal County is the Chief Judicial Executive Officer of the County and has administrative supervision over all courts in Pinal County pursuant to Article VI of the Arizona Constitution and Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 2017-79; and

WHEREAS, per Rule 4.1(d) of the Arizona Rules of Criminal Procedure, the presiding judge must set at least one fixed time each day for conducting initial appearances, and notify local law enforcement agencies of the fixed time(s).

IT IS ORDERED, setting initial appearances for non-juvenile **criminal cases and support enforcement cases**, each day, including weekends and holidays, at **10:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.**, before a judicial officer as designated by the Chief Pretrial Judge; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, setting initial appearances/detention reviews for **juvenile matters on weekdays**, at **1:15 p.m.**, and on **weekends and holidays at 11:30 a.m.** at the Youth Justice Center or as otherwise directed by the Presiding Juvenile Court Judge.

IT IS ORDERED that these changes take effect on **November 10, 2021**.
