ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

Pursuant to the Constitution of the State of Arizona, Article 6, Section 24, A.R.S. §12-213, as amended, and the Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court (RASC),

IT IS ORDERED that William J. O'Neil is hereby appointed as a Court Commissioner, Senior, of the Arizona Superior Court in Pinal County, on a part time basis, commencing January 3, 2022 and ending June 30, 2022, subject to annual reappointment by the Presiding Judge.

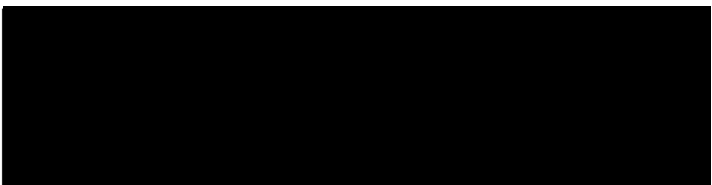

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that William J. O'Neil shall be compensated according to the A.R.S. §12-213(B) and the existing compensation plan for a Commissioner of the Arizona Superior Court in Pinal County, and

This appointment is conditioned upon the agreement to serve only for the compensation received as a Court Commissioner, Senior, while employed as a Commissioner by the Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that William J. O'Neil is assigned to hear and decide Criminal and Civil matters assigned to him by the Presiding Judge, or designee, without further written order.
