ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

WHEREAS the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in and for Pinal County is the chief judicial officer of the county and has administrative authority over all courts in Pinal County, pursuant to Article VI of the Arizona Constitution and Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 2017-79; and

Now, therefore,

Effective January 5, 2022, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the Virtual Court calendar will be reassigned from Judge Danielle Harris (DH) to Judge Matthew S. Reed (MSW). This calendar will include cases in which the Defendant is in the custody of the Arizona Department of Corrections, Rehabilitation and Reentry.

The Virtual Court calendar is a traditional criminal trial caseload and calendar and will handle criminal trials on his caseload (to the extent practicable) and is subject to case transfer of criminal trials to and from Judge Reed as directed by the Criminal Presiding Judge.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this calendar may be used for all appropriate uses, as directed and/or approved by the Presiding Criminal Judge.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all new ex parte motions filed in criminal matters on or after February 1, 2022, shall be assigned to Judge Lacey A. Stover Gard (LSG) or following consultation with the trial judge, may be reassigned to the trial judge.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall update its records to reflect the reassignment of such cases.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that effective immediately, the *Chief Pretrial Judge* (Pinal County Superior Court A.O. 2020-00056) be reassigned from Judge Delia R. Neal (DRN) to Judge Christopher J. O'Neil (CJO).

All other standing assignment orders shall remain unchanged.
