ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

NO. 2022- 00005

WHEREAS, all judicial employees are required, pursuant to Arizona Code of Judicial Administration 1-302: Education and Training, to obtain 16 hours of accredited training annually; and

WHEREAS, Pinal County Superior Court Administration is responsible to coordinate and report all judicial employees' compliance with Arizona Code of Judicial Administration 1-302: Education and Training; and

WHEREAS, it is recognized that the judiciary relies on having well-educated, trained staff and that relevant and meaningful training must be offered to all staff throughout the year, and

WHEREAS, each department within Pinal County Superior Court and the Justice and Municipal Courts, must have an employee designated as a Local Training Coordinator;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Pinal County Judicial Education and Training Committee is hereby established for the purposes of assisting the Superior Court to maintain judicial and administrative competence by developing, monitoring, and implementing educational opportunities, programs, and resources to encourage and promote excellence and competence in all court operations, and provide opportunities for compliance with all mandated education and training requirements.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Pinal County Superior Court Judicial Education and Training Committee be chaired by Superior Court Administration and that each of the departments listed below must select a representative and training coordinator, or other designated employee, to serve on, and actively contribute to the Pinal County Judicial Education Committee:
