WHEREAS the Honorable Brett Eisele, Justice of the Peace, Precinct No. 3, has resigned his position, effective January 22, 2022; and

WHEREAS the Presiding Judge finds that the appointment of a Justice of the Peace ProTempore is necessary, appropriate and in the best interest of the Judicial Branch of Government in Pinal County;

NOW, THEREFORE pursuant to A.R.S.§ 22-121(A),

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that Henry G. Gooday is hereby appointed to serve as Justice of the Peace *Pro Tempore*, Precinct 3, for a period commencing January 22, 2022 and ending upon certification of the General Election for Justice of the Peace, or, until the Pinal County Board of Supervisors have appointed a Justice of the Peace. In no case will this appointment extend beyond January 22, 2023.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Henry G. Gooday shall be compensated in accordance with state law under A.RS. §22-125, by funds allocated for such purposes from the budget of the Judicial Branch and/or the budget of the Justices of the Peace; and,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERD that Henry G. Gooday shall comply with all Judicial Canons and, receive any judicial training as required by the Administrative Offices of the Courts.
