ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

No. 2022 - 00 019

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary that Probate Accountants, for the purpose of conducting audits under Arizona Revised Statutes Title 14, Chapter 5, sections 5314 and 5414 may be appointed by the court; and

**WHEREAS**, such accountants are appointed for the purpose of providing the court with a report on the current financial status of a case involving a guardianship/conservatorship pursuant to A.R.S. §14-5314 and §14-5414; and

**WHEREAS**, Probate Accountants appointed under this rule shall have a combination of education and work experience as deemed appropriate by the Vulnerable Persons Unit (VPU) to qualify them to conduct audits;

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED**, only individuals who have met requirements set by the VPU will be appointed by the court. These appointments are at the pleasure and direction of the Presiding Probate Judge and may be terminated with or without cause at any time by the Presiding Probate Judge.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that all Probate Accountants be paid at a rate determined by the Presiding Judge.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that all Probate Accountants will submit reports on an approved form, maintained by the Vulnerable Persons Unit.
