NOW, THEREFORE pursuant to A.R.S. § 22-121(B),

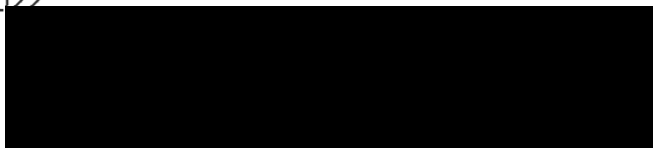
