ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

The Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in and for Pinal County is the chief judicial officer of the county and has administrative authority over all courts in Pinal County, pursuant to Article VI of the Arizona Constitution and Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 2017-79 C (1); and

The court has determined that adopting a uniform symbol or logo that helps court users identify materials and communications that both incorporates the mission of the Superior Court in Pinal County and reflects favorably upon the independent nature of the judicial branch is appropriate. By having a standard logo that can be used by all Superior Court Divisions and Departments, the court sends a consistent message to all court users.

IT IS ORDERED that the logo attached in Exhibit A is hereby adopted by the Arizona Superior Court in Pinal County.

IT IS ORDERED that the adopted logo may be used by all Superior Court Divisions and Departments on letterhead, websites, uniforms and other media.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the State Seal shall continue to be used in courtrooms behind the bench and in any other locations or documents required by rule or statute.
