The Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in and for Pinal County is the Chief Judicial Executive Officer of the County and has administrative supervision over all courts in Pinal County pursuant to Article VI of the Arizona Constitution and Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 2017-79; and

The Presiding Judge seeks to align the Court with the Chief Justice's "Justice for the Future: Planning for Excellence" Strategic Plan as it relates to promoting judicial branch excellence and innovation; and

The Court Processes Committee (CPC), a partnership between court leadership, is being created to foster collaboration and coordination as it relates to the operations of the Superior Court and its offices and departments. The CPC is dedicated to review and improve processes within the court system that impact multiple stakeholders.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the *Court Processes Committee* be established to meet these needs and be staffed by persons listed under separate Order of the Presiding Judge. The committee chair may add individuals to the committee, on an ad-hoc basis, as appropriate.
