WHEREAS the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in and for Pinal County is the chief judicial officer of the county and has administrative authority over all the courts in Pinal County, pursuant to Article VI of the Arizona Constitution and Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 2017-79; and,

WHEREAS the Honorable Henry G. Gooday, Justice of the Peace Pro-Tempore, Precinct No. 3, has resigned his position, effective June 10, 2022; and

WHEREAS the Presiding Judge finds that the appointment of a Justice of the Peace Pro-Tempore is necessary, appropriate and in the best interest of the Judicial Branch of Government in Pinal County;

NOW, THEREFORE pursuant to A.R.S. § 22-121(A),

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that **Daniel Hughes** is appointed to serve as Justice of the Peace *Pro Tempore*, Precinct 3, for a period commencing June 11, 2022 and ending upon certification of the General Election for Justice of the Peace, or, if necessary, a Special Election in May of 2023. If the Pinal County Board of Supervisors appoints a Justice of the Peace, this A.O. is automatically rescinded. In no case will this appointment extend beyond June 3, 2023.

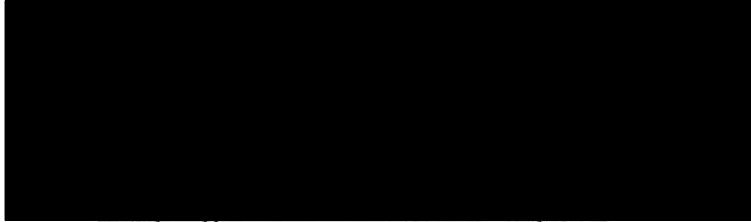
IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **Daniel Hughes** shall be compensated in accordance with state law under A.R.S. §22-125, by funds allocated for such purposes from the budget of the Judicial Branch and/or the budget of the Justices of the Peace; and,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **Daniel Hughes** shall comply with all Judicial Canons and, receive any judicial training as required by the Administrative Offices of the Courts.

Justice of the Peace *Pro Tempore* Appointment

This appointment is at the pleasure and direction of the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court. Such appointment may be terminated without cause at any time by the Presiding Judge.
