Administrative Order
No. 2022 – 00 044

The Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in and for Pinal County is the Chief Judicial Executive Officer of the County and has administrative supervision over all courts in Pinal County pursuant to Article VI of the Arizona Constitution and Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 2017-79; and

The Criminal Justice Coordinating Committee (CJCC) is a partnership between county and state criminal justice agencies and departments to address issues and needs arising within the justice system in Pinal County.

It is recognized that collaboration and coordination with all criminal justice stakeholders is necessary for true system improvement. The CJCC is dedicated to working together to continually improve the administration of justice in Pinal County and serves as a forum for identifying issues and their solutions, proposing actions and facilitating cooperation that will improve public safety and the related criminal/juvenile justice services in Pinal County; and

The Juvenile Justice Subcommittee (JJS) is a partnership between court leadership and is being created to foster collaboration and coordination as it relates to the operations of the Juvenile Court and its various missions. The JJS is dedicated to review and improve processes within the court system that impact multiple stakeholders.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the *Juvenile Justice Subcommittee* be established to meet these needs and be staffed by persons as listed in Appendix A. The committee chair may add individuals to the committee, on an ad-hoc basis, or as permanent members, as appropriate. Meetings are at the discretion of the Chair, unless otherwise directed by the Criminal Justice Coordination Committee.

The Chair has authority to implement solutions and/or processes as determined by the JJS or bring them to the CJCC for further discussion.
