Whereas, the Presiding Judge seeks to align the Court with the Chief Justice's "Justice for the Future" Strategic Plan as it relates to promoting judicial branch excellence and innovation; and

Whereas, pursuant to Arizona Supreme Court administrative order(s), attorneys are required to electronically file selected case documents in several case types when filing into the Superior Court in Pinal County; and

Whereas, it is necessary for all parties to receive timely notification of, or copies of Rulings, Orders or Notices that have been electronically filed with the Clerk of the Superior Court;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that effective August 1, 2022, in all case types that electronic filing has been approved by Arizona Supreme Court, the Clerk of the Superior Court shall be responsible for the distribution of all electronically filed Orders/Judgments to all appropriate parties within the designated case. The distribution process shall be completed in a timely manner and may be accomplished by any means available to the Clerk of the Superior Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED the distribution of any Rulings, Notices and Orders originating from the Judicial Divisions will continue to be completed by the assigned Judicial Administrative Assistant.
