**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
No. 2022-00 050**

Pursuant to the Constitution of the State of Arizona, Article 6, Section 24, A.R.S. §12-213, as amended, and the Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court (RASC),

**IT IS ORDERED** that Jamie R. Ramirez is hereby appointed as a Court Commissioner of the Arizona Superior Court in Pinal County, on a full time basis, commencing September 12, 2022 and ending June 30, 2023, subject to annual reappointment by the Presiding Judge.

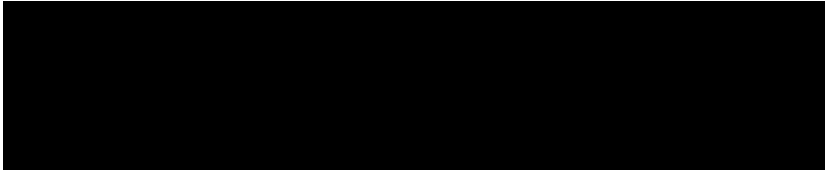
**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Jamie R. Ramirez shall have all such powers and duties pursuant to law which shall include, but not limited to, those powers and duties prescribed by A.R.S. §12-213, as amended, and Rule 96, RASC, as amended.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Jamie R. Ramirez shall be compensated according to A.R.S. §12-213(B) and the existing compensation plan for a Commissioner of the Arizona Superior Court in Pinal County, and

This appointment is conditioned upon the agreement to serve only for the compensation received as a Court Commissioner while employed as a Commissioner by the Court, and to receive no additional compensation or benefit, fiscal or otherwise, when acting in the capacity of a Judge Pro Tempore.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Jamie R. Ramirez is assigned to hear and decide matters assigned to him by the Presiding Judge, or designee, without further written order.
