ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

WHEREAS, the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in and for Pinal County is the chief judicial officer of the county and has administrative authority over all courts in Pinal County, pursuant to Article VI of the Arizona Constitution and Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 2017-79; and

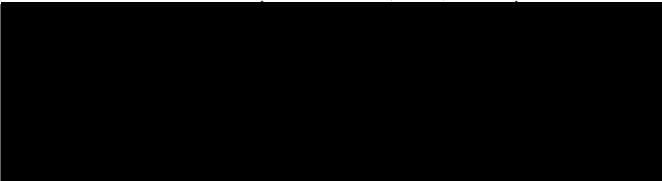
WHEREAS, Rule 4.3(b) of the Arizona Rules of Criminal Procedure states: "*The presiding Judge will set masters' compensation, which will be paid from any available funding source the presiding judge identifies.*"

IT IS ORDERED effective **November 1, 2022**, that all Initial Appearance Special Masters will be paid by the day (24 hour period) they serve as follows:

Weekdays (except holidays): \$400.00 per day
Weekends and Holidays: \$450.00 per day

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED adopting the Pinal County Superior Court Initial Appearance Special Master Procedure Manual dated January 14, 2022 and any subsequent modifications made therein.
