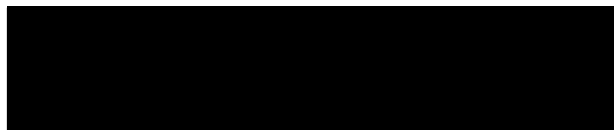
The Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in and for Pinal County is the Chief Judicial Executive Officer of the County and has administrative supervision over all courts in Pinal County pursuant to Article VI of the Arizona Constitution and Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 2017-79; and

The Presiding Judge seeks to align the Court with the Chief Justice’s “Justice for the Future: Planning for Excellence” Strategic Plan as it relates to promoting judicial branch excellence and innovation; and

The Technology Governance Board (TGB), a partnership between court leadership, was established to foster collaboration and coordination as it relates to information technology and resources. The TGB has determined that a subcommittee dedicated to processes within the court system is necessary to address issues that affect multiple stakeholders.

Therefore, it is hereby ordered that the *Court Processes Subcommittee* be created to meet these needs and the persons listed in Appendix A are hereby appointed to this committee. The committee chair may add individuals to the committee, on an ad-hoc basis, if the need arises.
